*Named for an ancient city that resisted Roman invaders, this is a deep, dark interpretation of Tempranillo that fully expresses the extreme climate of the region*

#### ITALY

**Tolaini, 'Valdisanti', Super Tuscan, 2011** Tuscany 70  
*An up-and-coming rockstar in Tuscany producing easy drinking Super Tuscan styled wines*

**Masi, 'Campofiorin', Rosso del Veronese, 2011** Veneto 75  
*The original 'Super-Venetian' created by Masi in 1964*

**Mazzei, 'Ser Lapo', Chianti Classico Riserva, 2013** Tuscany 80  
*Named for the famed winemaker of Carmignano in the 15<sup>th</sup> Century!*

**Masi, 'Costasera', Amarone Classico, 2011** Veneto 135  
*The product of Masi's unrivalled expertise in the appassimento technique*

**Tenuta di Biserno, 'il Pino', Toscana IGT, 2012** Tuscany 140  
*30 parcels that make up the planted acres were carefully selected based on slope, soil composition, and the influence of sea breezes*

**Tenuta San Guido, 'Guidalberto', Toscana IGT, 2014** Tuscany 145  
*Guidalberto is the second wine from the producers of the legendary Sassicaia*

**Grattamacco, 'l'Alberello', Bolgheri Rosso Superiore, 2012** Tuscany 150  
*Grattamacco was founded in 1977 and is located in the prestigious Bolgheri DOC*

**Rocche dei Manzoni, 'Vigna Capella di S. Stefano', Barolo, 1997** Piedmont 160  
*This wine ages for 24 months in oak barrels and for 12 months in bottle prior to its release*

**Dario Princic, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2001** Friuli-Venezia Giulia 185  
*The 7 hectares of vineyards have been farmed without chemicals since 1988*

**Marchesi Antinori, 'Tignanello', Toscana IGT, 2013** Tuscany 250  
*Tignanello is produced exclusively from the vineyard of the same name, a parcel of some 140 acres*

**Aldo Conterno, 'Cicala', Barolo, 2000** Piedmont 375  
*Aldo's wines are some of the best made in Italy, and his greatest cru is Cicala*

**Tenuta San Guido, 'Sassicaia', Bolgheri, 2011** Tuscany 500  
*Sassicaia is considered one of Italy's leading Bordeaux-style red wines*
